

Is the evidence relevant only because it affects the assessment of the credibility of a witness or is it relevant for a credibility purpose and another purpose for which it is not admissible? **s 101A**

YES

Credibility evidence is not admissible unless an exception applies **s 102**

Is the evidence being led in cross-examination? **s 103**

YES

Is the evidence capable of substantially affecting the assessment of the credibility of the witness? **s 103**

YES

Is leave required (criminal proceeding)? **s 104**

YES

Should leave be granted? **s 104 and s 192**

YES

Is the evidence being led in chief to rebut a denial in cross-examination? **s 106**

YES

Has the matter been put to the witness in cross examination and denied, not admitted, or not agreed to? **s 106**

YES

Is leave required? **s 106(2)**

YES

Should leave be granted? **s 192**

YES

Is the evidence led in reexamination? **s 108(1)**

YES

Does the matter arise from cross examination, or has leave been granted? **s 39 and s 192**

YES

Is it evidence of a prior consistent statement? **s 108(3)**

YES

Has a prior inconsistent statement been admitted, or is it or will it be suggested that evidence is fabricated, reconstructed or the result of suggestion? **s 108(3)**

YES

Is it evidence of specialised knowledge? **s 108C**

YES

Is the evidence capable of substantially affecting a witness's credibility? **s 108C**

YES

Is it character evidence? **s 110**

YES

Is it led by the defendant to prove good character, or is it led to rebut the defendant's evidence of good character? **s 110**

YES

Is leave required? **s 112**

NO

Should leave be granted? **s 192**

YES

OR

Was evidence of a previous representation admitted in the proceeding and its maker not called to give evidence? **s 108A**

YES

Is the credibility evidence capable of substantially affecting the assessment of the credibility of the maker of the representation? **s 108A(1)**

YES

Is leave required (criminal proceeding)? **s 108B**

NO

Should leave be granted? **s 108B and s 192**

YES

EVIDENCE IS ADMISSIBLE ON THE CREDIBILITY OF WITNESS
